Tin Foil Heart

Space:

Table with plastic covering

Ages:

Any age

Supplies:

Cardboard
Aluminum Foil
Permanent Markers
Scissors



Instructions:

1. Cut a heart shape out of a piece of cardboard
2. Cut off a sheet of aluminum foil a little bigger than the size of your heart.
3. Fold the aluminum foil around your cardboard heart, covering it completely.
4. Use permanent markers to decorate and create any design of your choice

Mosaic Heart

Space:

Table

Ages:

3-5

Supplies:

White, red and pink construction paper
Scissors
Glue
Container



Instructions:

1. Grownups cut red and pink construction paper into strips
2. Child will cut strips independently into their mosaic tiles
3. Grownup will draw a big heart on white construction paper and cut it out
4. Child applies glue to the heart
5. Child applies cut paper to the heart
6. Let dry
7. You can hang up or give as a Valentine!
