**Re: Request for Access to Information Under Part II of the
Access to Information and Protection Privacy Act**

On March 10, 2017, the City of St. John's received your request for access to the following information:

"I am requesting access to all records relating to the Mile One Centre St. John's, including but not limited to briefing notes between the dates of July 1, 2016 and Dec. 31, 2016. Please exclude material considered to be a matter of confidence."

On March 17, 2017, at our request, you provided further clarification as follows:

"With regards to my request, any/all issues between the City and Mile One is perfect."

We have conducted a search based on the criteria provided and are unable to provide the information requested as per section 28 (1) (c) of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act:

28. (1) The head of a local public body may refuse to disclose to an applicant information that would reveal

(c) the substance of deliberations of a meeting of its elected officials or governing body or a committee of its elected officials or governing body, where an Act authorizes the holding of a meeting in the absence of the public.
